Red Wine

La Joya Merlot

Smoky black raspberry aromas leading to a velvety texture with black cherry notes and a vanilla-tinged finish (Chile) Glass 5.00 Bottle 17.00

Oakley 5 Reds

Blend of Syrah, Zinfandel, Grenache, Mourvede, and Carrignan. Like a soft and subtle zinfandel (California) Glass 5.50 Bottle 19.00

Protocolo Tempranillo

Rich with chocolate and black cherry flavors, this wine is almost sweet on the palate, with ripe, well-integrated tannins and a spicy finish (Spain) Glass 4.00 Bottle 15.00

Rosenblum Zinfandel

From a Highland Park family, Craig's mom used to babysit these guys, this delicious zin provides a lush and textured palate of bright raspberry jam and spicy notes of cedar (California) Glass 6.50 Bottle 23.00

Los Cardos Malbec

Complex, reflecting typical characteristics of an Argentine Malbec, this wine is soft, fresh, full-bodied, and delightful (Argentina) Glass 6.00 Bottle 21.00

Le Grand Pinot Noir

Distinctive, spice-tinged wine with deep cherry notes and a touch of vanilla (France) Glass 6.00 Bottle 21.00

Avalon Cabernet Sauvignon

Rich, slightly smoky aromas of cherries, boysenberries, and chocolate. Subtle notes of vanilla and spice (California) Glass 6.50 Bottle 22.00

Sangria

Borrowed from an Irish shepherd in the mountain village of Bubillon, an authentic Spanish recipe of red wine, citrus and spice (minus the brandy) Glass 5.00

White Wine

Banrock Station Chardonnay

This sassy wine reveals a full palate of tropical fruit – peach, rockmelon, and pear – coupled with subtle hints of oak (Australia) Glass 4.00 Bottle 15.00

Ecco Domani Pinot Grigio

Pleasant nose, with tropical fruit and floral fragrances (Italy) Glass 5.50 Bottle 19.00

Woodbridge Riesling

Refreshing fruit, floral, and mineral notes in the aromas followed by lightly sweet and crisp flavors (California) Glass 5.00 Bottle 18.00

Tin Roof Sauvignon Blanc

David Ready, Jr. – one of their winemakers – is from Minnesota. The name comes from a shed in his backyard growing up. Crisp and bright, this Sauvignon Blanc is very fruity and lightly herbal in style with notes of grapefruit, lemon grass, and plum (California) Glass 5.50 Bottle 19.00
